Lutheran. I checked


with church council in December about starting this and would like to have a meeting on Feb 11 after late service to start making plans.

Peanut butter (12 oz can) & a sleeve of crackers, beans & franks (pop-top can), beef stew (pop-top can), Spaghetti-Os, beef jerky, cereal, fruit cups, raisins, pudding cups, juice boxes, milk (aseptic pack boxes that do not require refrigeration), cereal or granola bars
