






Our theme for Lent this year is "The Way of the Cross". Each Wednesday during Lent, we will have a meal that starts at 6:15pm and a short worship service that starts at 7:00. For

worship we are using a liturgy called "Prayer Around the Cross" and they have a very different feel than our normal Sunday worship services – quieter, darker, acoustic, more contemplative – as we explore deep questions surrounding the cross like: Why did Jesus have to die on a cross? How does the cross save us? What does the cross mean for us today and how can we follow Jesus in the way of the cross?

This will be a countywide gathering of all the congregations & participants, where we will hear a report from the Research Teams and a detailed plan for the solutions that we will be seeking. The Research Teams (including Alan Wondra) have been hard at work since November identifying the underlying problems with mental illness & homelessness in our community, and they have come up with some strong, winnable, justice-oriented solutions. This is what we'll hear about on April 11th.

Our even bigger & more important Nehemiah Assembly will take place on Thursday, May 9th. Even if you can't make it to April's Solutions Rally, please plan to attend the Nehemiah Assembly on May 9th. That is the event where we need as many people as possible to show up. You can work for justice simply by being present and gathering with the other thousands of people of faith in our community working for justice. The more people we have attend, the bigger impact it will make.
