






## **EASTER TRADITIONS**

This year, we will continue some important Easter Traditions here at Christ Lutheran, including:

- Flowering the Cross Each person/family is invited to bring fresh cut flowers from home to decorate the cross in the sanctuary. On Good Friday, we will each hammer a nail into the cross, and then on Easter Sunday, those same nails are used to hold the flowers, symbolizing the new life that Jesus gives us at his resurrection. Don't worry if you forget to bring flowers, we'll have plenty extra on hand, just in case.
- **Easter Egg Hunt** This event for the children will begin in the sanctuary at 10:15am. Each child who comes will be able to fill their baskets full of candy-stuffed eggs to celebrate.
- Sweetbreads & Cinnamon Rolls While we don't do a big Easter brunch, we do invite folks to bring extra goodies, sweet breads, cinnamon rolls, juice, or anything else you'd like to share after or between services. There will be no Sunday school. The time between services is for the egg hunt and fellowship among friends. You are encouraged to bring something to share.

#### **EASTER EGG HUNT & CANDY**

We will be having an Easter Egg hunt for our children on Easter Sunday between the services. To participate, you'll want to be in the sanctuary by 10:15 on Easter Sunday.

If you would like to donate candy to help with this effort, there is a box near the Opportunity Table. You can put your candy in there and someone else will stuff the eggs. Thank you!


# <u>JUSTICE TOGETHER – SOLUTIONS RALLY!</u>

United Methodist Church (339 N. Broadway). This will be a countywide gathering of all the congregations & participants, where we will hear a report from the Research Teams and a detailed plan for the solutions that we will be seeking. The Research Teams (including Alan Wondra) have been hard at work since November identifying the underlying problems with mental illness & homelessness in our community, and they have come up with some strong, winnable, justice-oriented solutions. This is what we'll hear about on April 11<sup>th</sup>.

Our even bigger & more important Nehemiah Assembly will take place on Thursday, May 9<sup>th</sup>. Even if you can't make it to April's Solutions Rally, please plan to attend the Nehemiah Assembly on May 9<sup>th</sup>. That is the event where we need as many people as possible to show up. You can work for justice simply by being present and gathering with the other thousands of people of faith in our community working for justice. The more people we have attend, the bigger impact it will make.
