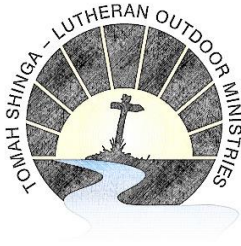

CONGREGATION MEETING

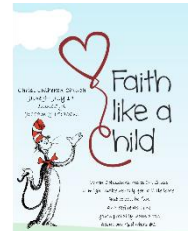
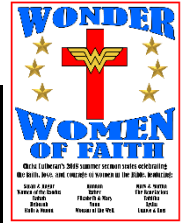
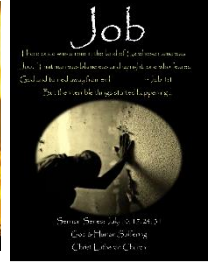
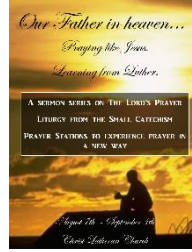

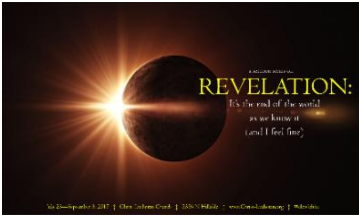
- Approval for the final financials from 2023 – There are copies of the 2023 Year End Treasurer's Report on the Opportunity Table

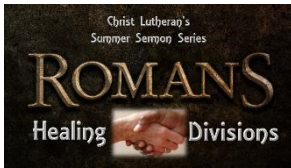
