JANUARY 2026 NEWS FLASH-- TWO GATES, TWO TREES, AND TWO HOUSES: JESUS' CLEAR WARNINGS FROM MATTHEW CHAPTER 7

ONE OF MY FAVORITE THINGS ABOUT STUDYING THE BIBLE IS JESUS' ILLUSTRATIONS. HE WAS A TERRIFIC STORYTELLER, OFTEN USING PARABLES TO CONVEY IMPORTANT MESSAGES IN A MEMORABLE WAY. IN MATTHEW CHAPTER 7, WHEN JESUS TELLS US THAT THERE ARE TWO GATES, OR TWO PATHS THAT WE CAN FOLLOW AS WE LIVE OUR LIVES: JESUS SAYS " ENTER THROUGH THE NARROW GATE; FOR THE GATE IS WIDE AND THE WAY IS BROAD THAT LEADS TO DESTRUCTION, AND THERE ARE MANY WHO ENTER THOUGH IT. FOR THE GATE IS SMALL AND THE WAY IS NARROW THAT LEADS TO LIFE, AND THERE ARE FEW WHO FIND IT" MATT :7 13-14.

THE WIDE GATE REPRESENTS OUR CULTURE TODAY, CHARACTERIZED BY SELF-DEPENDENT, SELF-ABSORBED AND WANTING TO APPEAR OUTWARDLY BETTER THAN EVERYONE ELSE. THE NARROW GATE SAYS JESUS DIED FOR YOU; YOU NEED TO LIVE YOUR LIFE FOR HIM. THE NARROW GATE HAS A DEEP PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH CHRIST. THE TWO TREES. JESUS SAYS" BEWARE OF THE FALSE PROPHETS, WHO COME TO YOU IN SHEEP'S CLOTHING, BUT INWARDLY ARE RAVENOUS WOLVES. YOU WILL KNOW THEM BY THEIR FRUITS. GRAPES ARE NOT GATHERED FROM THORN BUSHES NOR FIGS FROM THISTLES, ARE THEY? SO EVERY GOOD TREE BEARS GOOD FRUIT, BUT THE BAD TREE FRUIT IS CUT DOWN AND THROWN INTO THE FIRE. SO THEN, YOU WILL KNOW THEM BY THEIR FRUITS." MATT. 7:15-20. JESUS IS TELLING US TO BE AWARE OF THOSE PEOPLE, EVEN THOUGH THEY APPEAR RELIGIOUS ON THE OUTSIDE. THEY WILL DECEIVE YOU AND PULL YOU AWAY FROM THE TRUE WORD OF GOD. JESUS FINAL WARNING IN THIS PASSAGE IS THE COMMUNICATED THROUGH A COMPARISON OF TWO HOUSES, ONE BUILT ON ROCK AN ONE BUILT ON SAND.

JESUS SAYS " THEREFORE EVERYONE WHO HEARS THESE WORDS OF MINE AND ACTS ON THEM, MAY BE COMPARED TO A WISE MAN WHO BUILT HIS HOUSE ON ROCK. THE RAIN FELL, AND THE FLOODS CAME, AND THE WINDS BLEW AND SLAMMED AGAINST THE HOUSE; AND YET IT DID NOT FALL, FOR IT HAD BEEN FOUNDED ON THE ROCK. EVERYONE WHO HEARS THESE WORDS AND DOES NOT ACT ON THEM , WILL BE LIKE A FOOLISH MAN WHO BUILT HIS HOUSE ON THE SAND". MATT 7:24-27. JESUS' FINAL WARNING AND CHALLENGE TO US IN THIS CHAPTER IS THAT IT'S UP TO EACH OF US TO EXERCISE OUR FREE WILL AND CHOOSE BETWEEN LIFE WITH HIM OR A LIFE OF DESTRUCTION.

This past year we surpassed 2000 Bags of Blessings that were shared with and handed out by 32 different agencies in and around the Wichita area. Since we began looking for available bulk item outlets, we've been able to receive significant discounts from bulk vendors. Where in the past one hygiene bag might cost about \$20, using the bulk items has dropped the unit cost by 20% - 30%.

With all that in mind, we are refocusing our Bags of Blessings fundraising strategy. While we will never turn away the donation of actual goods, we want to emphasize monetary donations.

Two Ways to Support Partners for Wichita's Bags of Blessings:

- CLC is providing envelopes for donations to the Bags of Blessings project. Cash or checks made to CLC with Bags of Blessing in the memo line. Also, Noisy Offering on the second Sunday will support this ministry.
- However, you may also donate the individual items needed for the bags. See provided list to take for shopping.



