
## Class of 2026 – Senior Sunday



## ENDOWMENT COMMITTEE UPDATE

After the vote and approval by the Church Council in February, the following two items will be funded from the 2025 interest money:



- 1) Worship Committee - \$500 for the potential purchase of new linens in 2026.
- 2) Building and Grounds - \$2,000 was awarded to Alan Schmidt and his Building and Grounds are. Council has been talking for some months about looking for extra security items for the South side of the Church and the West end of the parking lot. Alan has done a lot of research and believes he can accomplish what we have discussed with these funds.

This leaves a little over \$365 in the Endowment fund. It will be used as interest funds in 2026

Thank you to the Endowment Committee. 2025 was a very easy year to decide where to allocate the funds. Next year in November and December we will be asking the congregation again for items that could be funded by interest funds from the Endowment Fund.
