TRIVIA NIGHT FUNDRAISER

Falcon Fellowship is hosting their 9th **Trivia Night Fundraiser** **THIS Saturday, October 3, 2026.** Trivia Night will be held at Christ Lutheran Church, across the street from **Heights High School**. Doors will open at 6:30 p.m., and trivia will begin at 7:00 p.m. The cost is \$120 for teams of eight people, or \$15 per individual (who will be placed in potluck teams). The price of admission includes a fun-filled night of trivia and laughs, soda, water, and table snacks. Please feel free to bring your own snacks, but please no alcohol.

What is **TRIVIA NIGHT**?

Teams of eight people compete against other teams through ten rounds of t. a. Each round will have ten questions, and the team works together to answer the questions. At the end of the night, the team with the most correct answers wins a prize. There is plenty of time between rounds for conversation, laughter, and fun. Trivia categories can vary greatly. Throughout the evening, we'll play other fun little games, such as a 50/50 raffle, etc., as well as have attendance prizes), trying to raise as much money as possible to support **Wichita Heights High School Ministry**.

What is **HEIGHTS MINISTRY/FALCON FELLOWSHIP**?

This is a ministry reaching out to the students at **Heights High School**. Each day Christ Lutheran welcomes about 80-120+ students into their doors during the lunch period. The kids get free snacks and a safer, quieter place to hang out during lunch. This school year we are restarting a monthly event dubbed “**Falcon Fellowship**” in which the church cooks an entire meal for the students, and they get to hear a gospel message given by a local youth pastor. It may be the only time that some of these students hear about Jesus. This outreach ministry has been going on for over 28 years and has reached thousands of students in that time.
